

Lochaber Centre Update

After months of hard work by various community volunteers, the LCDA has now submitted our proposal to the Provincial and Federal Governments for consideration.

This would not be possible without the tremendous financial support of Lochaber residents and friends of Lochaber, who, to date have pledged over \$342,000.00 towards this terrific community development. A \$75,000.00 commitment from the Municipality of the County of Antigonish and a \$30,000.00 pledge from Nova Scotia Health and Wellness has us well on our way.

Initially a plan to replace our Sylvan Hall, it has developed into a vision for a regional recreation centre that will in the near future, among other things, host rowing regattas which will attract participants from beyond our region and contribute to the economy of this area.

The centrepiece of this development will be the Lochaber Centre. A multi-use facility capable of hosting various events and activities. Along with the new building we intend to create an outdoor recreation facility to offer activities for all ages and physical abilities.

We are very pleased to have partnered with the Antigonish and STFX Rowing Clubs who have begun to train on Lochaber Lake. Their excitement for what we are planning here in Lochaber is contagious.
